### Does it cost anything to use the website?

FloridaLawHelp.org is free. You will never be charged for using any resources on this website.

However, you may have to pay to file documents in court. If you can't afford to pay the court filing fees, you can fill out an application for indigency to see if the court will waive the fees.

## **Who created the legal resources on this website (articles, forms, etc.)?**

The resources on this website are created by legal services attorneys throughout Florida as well as Florida Justice Technology Center staff.

## **How often are the legal resources updated?**

The resources are updated on a rolling basis because laws often change. We do our best to keep the information on this site up-to-date and reliable.

An entire review of resources is typically done annually to make sure resources are current.
